## Urban Intelligence for Healthy & Equitable Places

The Australian Urban Research Infrastructure Network (AURIN) and The University of Queensland have launched **URBANiQ - the AURIN Node for Urban Intelligence for Healthy & Equitable Places.**

URBANiQ brings together researchers across The University of Queensland with expertise in health, health inequities, urban planning, geography, transport, and social sciences. URBANiQ will harness AURIN mobility, environmental, and health data to respond to policy-led challenges to understand how the places we live, work, and socialise can promote urban liveability, facilitate healthy behaviour, and promote equity and sustainability.

The node will:



Lead **high-impact research** related to mobility, health & environmental exposure, and urban liveability & community wellbeing.



Conduct **stakeholder workshops** with researchers, government, industry, NGOs, and community representatives, to develop further policy-relevant work related to urban liveability, mobility and health.
